PERMITTING FOR ACCESSORY STRUCTURES


Sammamish Municipal Code doesn't require a building permit for an accessory structure if it is:

- Used for storage
- No more than 200 sq. ft. & no more than 12 ft. high (except one-story tree-houses)
- Located on a site that is not in a critical area or buffer

Due to the size of most accessory structures, you will likely need a permit. Additionally, you'll need a permit for any electric or plumbing work on the structure. Please see Getting Started and the Permitting Process for more details on how to get started and what to expect.

DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS FOR ACCESSORY STRUCTURES

All accessory structures must follow the development standards which inform the size & location of accessory structures and vary by zone.



ZONING DISTRICT	MAXIMUM HEIGHT	MINIMUM SETBACKS		
		FRONT YARD	REAR YARD	SIDE YARD
R-1	35 ft	20 ft	10 ft	10 ft
R-4 & R-6	35 ft	15 ft	10 ft	15 ft
R-8	35 ft	10 ft	10 ft	10 ft
R-12 & R-18	60 ft	10 ft	5 ft	5 ft

SETBACK EXCEPTIONS

Regardless of your zoning district, if your property is on a major street the minimum setback front yard is 30 feet. You can reduce rear & side yard setbacks to 5 feet by having an agreement from the adjoining property owner that is recorded with the King County Recorder's Office¹.
